

Frill Edge Scarf in Feathery Yarn

The frill ends on this Scarf are simple to make and add an interesting effect.



SIZE:

Width: 17cm (6¾ inches)
Length (or length desired): 150cm (59 inches)

YARN REQUIRED:

Approx 200g of a feathery type yarn.
Quantities vary between knitters and types of yarns.

NEEDLES:

1 pair of 4.50mm (UK 7, US 7) knitting needles.
Wool needle for sewing in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS:

beg = beginning; **cont** = continue; **inc** = increase; **K** = knit; **K2tog** = knit two sts together; **rep** = repeat; **stocking st** = knit one row then purl one row; **sts** = stitches.

Scarf

Using 4.50mm needles, cast on 120 sts.

Work 2 rows stocking st.

3rd row: * K2tog, rep from * to end ... 60 sts.

Purl 1 row.

5th row: * K2tog, rep from * to end ... 30 sts.

Cont in stocking st until Scarf measures approx 147cm (or length desired) ending with a purl row.

Next row: Inc knitways in each st ... 60 sts.

Purl 1 row.

Next row: Inc knitways in each st ... 120 sts.

Work 2 rows stocking st, beg with a purl row.

Cast off loosely purlways.

Finishing

Sew in all ends.
