

This simple, open stitch scarf is knitted using two strands of 8ply yarn together.



## SIZE:

Width: 13cm (5 inches)  
Length (or length desired): 150cm (59 inches)

## YARN REQUIRED:

Approx 120g of 8ply yarn.  
Quantities vary between knitters and types of yarns.

## NEEDLES:

1 pair of 8.00mm (UK 0, US 11) knitting needles.  
Wool needle for sewing in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS:

**cm** = centimetres; **cont** = continue; **K** = knit; **patt** = pattern;  
**pssso** = pass slipped stitch over; **rep** = repeat; **sl** = slip;  
**sts** = stitches; **yfwd** = yarn forward.

## Scarf

Using 8.00mm needles and yarn double, cast on 17 sts.

**1st row:** Knit.

**2nd row:** Knit.

**3rd row:** K1, \* yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, rep from \* to end.

**4th row:** Knit.

Rows 1 to 4 form patt.

Cont in patt until Scarf measures 150cm (or length desired), ending with a 4th patt row.

Cast off loosely knitways.

## Finishing

Sew in all ends.
