

This beanie uses two strands of 8ply yarn knitted together on 7.00mm needles making it a quick knit and very warm to wear.



SIZES:

Age:	2-4 years	6-8 years	Adult
To Fit head	51-52	53-55	56 cm
	20-20½	21-21¾	22 inches

YARN REQUIRED:

Approx 90g of 8ply yarn used double
Quantities vary between knitters and types of yarns.

NEEDLES:

1 pair of 7.00mm (UK 2, US 10½) knitting needles.
Wool needle for sewing up.

TENSION:

13 sts and 19 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 7.00mm needles and yarn double.

ABBREVIATIONS:

alt = alternate; **beg** = beginning; **cm** = centimetres; **dec** = decrease; **K** = knit; **K2tog** = knit two stitches together; **P** = purl; **rem** = remaining; **rep** = repeat; **stocking st** = knit 1 row then purl 1 row; **sts** = stitches.

Beanie

Using 7.00mm needles and yarn double, cast on 57 (**59-61**) sts.

1st row: K1, * P1, K1, rep from * to end.

2nd row: K2, * P1, K1, rep from * to last st, K1.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows until brim measures 8cm, ending with a 2nd row.

Work in stocking st until Beanie measures 16 (**17-19**) cm from beg, ending with a knit row.

Next row: Purl and dec 0 (**2-4**) sts evenly across ... 57 sts.

Shape Crown:

1st row: K1, * K2tog, K5, rep from * to end ... 49 sts.

2nd and alt rows: Purl.

3rd row: K1, * K2tog, K4, rep from * to end.

5th row: K1, * K2tog, K3, rep from * to end.

7th row: K1, * K2tog, K2, rep from * to end.

9th row: K1, * K2tog, K1, rep from * to end ... 17 sts.

11th row: K1, * K2tog, rep from * to end ... 9 sts.

Break off yarn, run end through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely.

Finishing

Join back seam of Beanie, reversing seam for lower 4cm for Brim.

Sew in all ends. Fold up brim.
