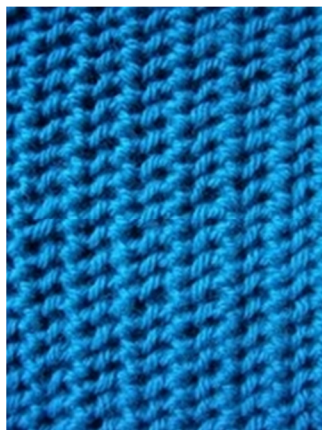


This pretty, open stitch is created by using large needles and simple slip and knit stitches.



SIZE:

Width: 16cm (6¼ inches)
Length (or length desired): 160cm (64 inches)

YARN REQUIRED:

Approx 150g of 12ply yarn.
Quantities vary between knitters and types of yarns.

NEEDLES:

1 pair of 7.00mm (UK 2, US 10½) knitting needles.
Wool needle for sewing in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS:

cm = centimetres; **K** = knit; **psso** = pass slipped stitch over;
rep = repeat; **sl** = slip; **sts** = stitches; **yfwd** = yarn forward.

Scarf

Using 7.00mm needles, cast on 18 sts.

1st row: K1, * yfwd, sl 1, K1, psso, rep from * to last st, K1.
Rep 1st row until Scarf measures 160cm (or length desired).
Cast off.

Finishing

Sew in all ends.
